Overview

Representative Sean Casten, a former clean energy entrepreneur, is one of the most knowledgeable and dedicated climate-focused representatives in the House. Positions on Energy and Climate

Rep. Casten has developed expertise across a wide range of topics under the climate umbrella.

By translating this knowledge into policy, he has introduced a number of important climate-focused bills. He was one of the two authors in the House for the Better Energy Storage Technology Act - which passed through Congress with bipartisan support - which would create a battery energy research and demonstration program. He also introduced, with Representative Tonko, the EV GRID Act to meet the increasing electricity demand of EV charging infrastructure.
